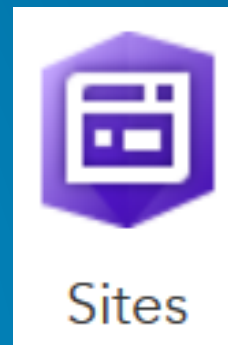

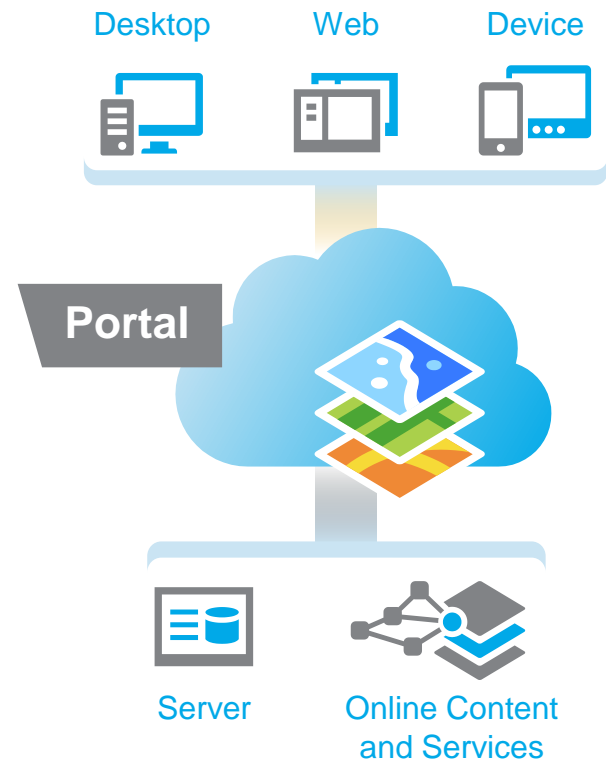

New feature within ArcGIS Enterprise 10.6.1 that allows us to create custom webpages for end users by your enterprise data

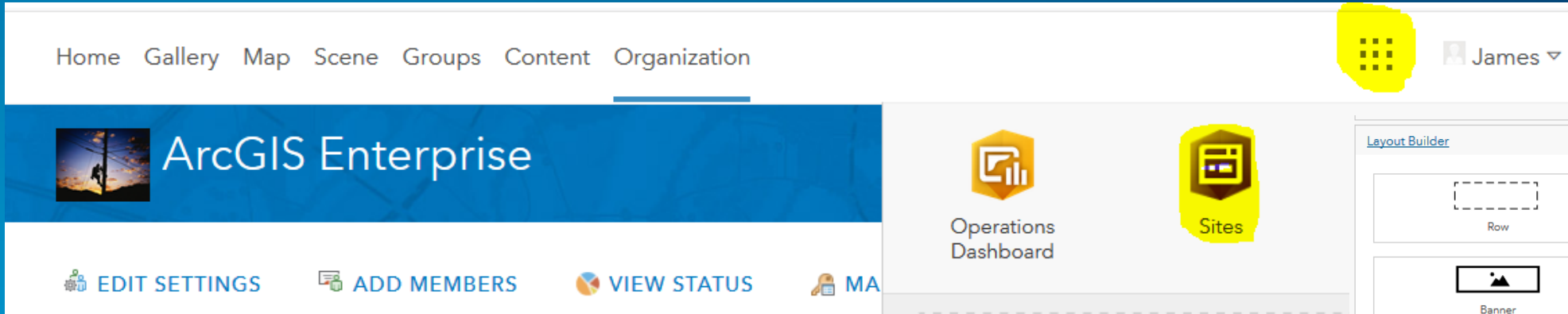


- Create a **tailored web page** experience for your users
- Help you **share** your portal's authoritative GIS data to other departments more **easily**
- Sites can easily be **navigated** by non-GIS users offering a richer **intuitive** experience
- **No programmer** experience simply drag and drop
- Add non-GIS content, e.g. **videos** and **documents**
- Create as many independent, tailored web pages as you want
- Users can be added to the Sites team to create web pages using ArcGIS Enterprise Sites.

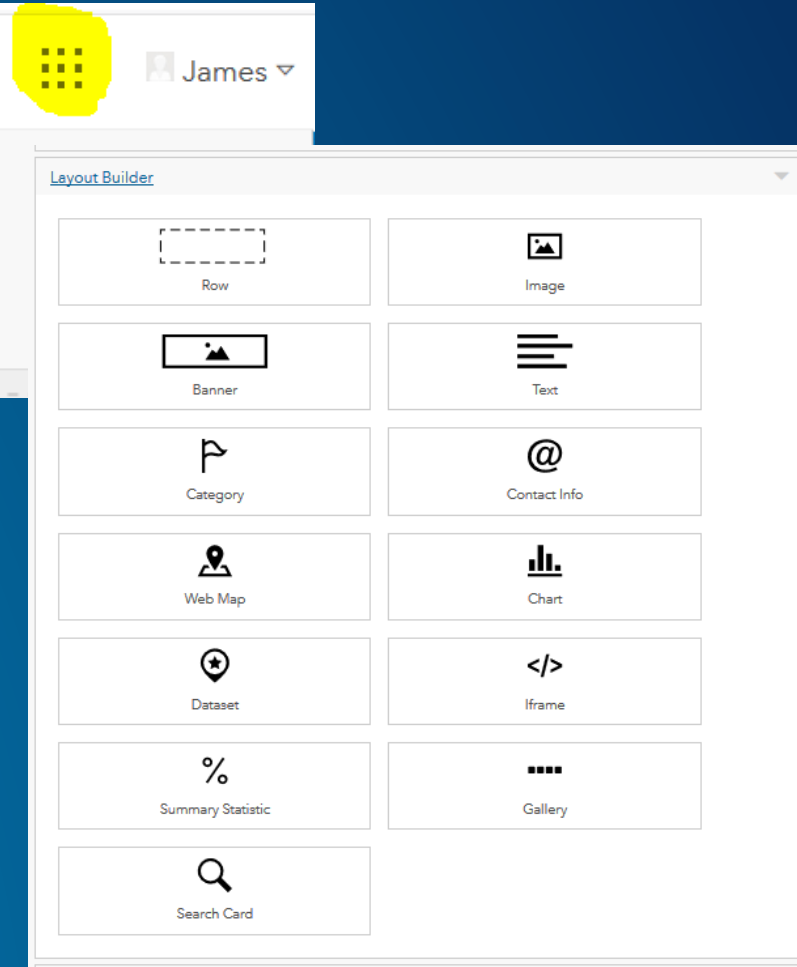
ArcGIS Enterprise Sites

- ArcGIS Enterprise Sites is **available to all** ArcGIS Enterprise customers upgrading to 10.6.1.
- There are **no additional costs** and no additional licensing is required.
- Users can go directly to the custom web page (site) for content instead of navigating to a **Group** in Portal for ArcGIS.
- Security and access to the Site and Content are **guaranteed** through Portal for ArcGIS.
- ArcGIS Enterprise Sites includes "**Site**" as a custom web page,
 - the "**Pages**" as a subset of a Site (sub-page), and
 - the "**Team**" as users who access the Site Manager and can create, edit or delete the Sites and Pages.

How to get started



- Upgrade to ArcGIS Enterprise 10.6.1.
- Log in to Portal for ArcGIS
- Access Apps shortcut and click on Sites
- Create New Site
- Build Site with Site Editor
